JakeTheSnake16 slithers past Hovantime!

In what was billed as the ultimate matchup between two perennial playoff adversaries, Cupcake Bowl VIII lived up to the hype. On Dec 23rd, 2012, third-seeded JakeTheSnake16 capped off a sensational late season run as they beat top-seeded Hovantime! 113-107 in a Cupcake Bowl upset.

These two teams seem to always meet in the playoffs. Together, these teams have squared off in 4 playoff battles. With this last victory, JakeTheSnake16 improved to 3-1 vs. Hovantime! in the postseason.

Note: WR Eric Decker earned Cupcake Bowl MVP honors with his dominant 21pt performance.

Each team's roster had a healthy mix of players both young and old. In fact, 8 players listed on yesterday's combined playoff roster had suited up for at least one of the previous 3 playoff matchups between these bitter rivals.

Names like Ben Roethlisberger, Steven Jackson, Michael Turner, Knowshon Moreno, Vincent Jackson, Matt Prater and the Denver D reminded fans of the playoff battles of old. Yet the man who got the most cheers and jeers on Monday was Hovantime! captain, Drew Brees.

Let's take a look at this rivalry and explore Drew Brees's unique impact on it.

JakeTheSnake16 Vs. Hovantime! Timeline:

Dec 28th 2006: The Game

JakeTheSnake16 sends Hovantime! packing 102-90 in the CSFFL Semi-finals.

Dec 29th 2006: The Decision

Dismizzle, Hovantime! CEO, has just organized an impromptu press conference to announce that Hovantime! will not renew the contract of team captain Drew Brees. He cites his team's recent playoff struggles with Brees at the helm.

Aug 28th 2007: The Shock

JakeTheSnake16 pulls off a draft day shocker by letting Cupcake Bowl winning QB Tom Brady leave and select Drew Brees with the 7th pick of the 2007 CSFFL draft.

Dec 30th 2007: Cupcake Bowl IV – The Upset

Known by fans as, "the frosting bowl", Cupcake Bowl IV saw the third-seeded JakeTheSnake16 march into snowy Christopher J. Hovan Stadium to face the top-seeded Hovantime!. JakeTheSnake16 pulls off a shocking 105-89 upset.

Dec 30th- Jan 5th 2007: The Speech/ The JMD Incident

Dec 30th was a bitter sweet day for JakeTheSnake16 fans, as it would be Drew Brees's last game wearing orange and blue. While accepting the Cupcake Bowl MVP award, Brees makes disparaging remarks towards Head Coach/GM Alexander deWheelchair. This prompts deWheelchair to go Josh Mcdaniels on his ass. He is released within days and claimed the Beluga Whales.

Aug 31st 2009: Brees comes home

Dismizzle buries the hatchet with Brees and signs him to a one year deal. Brees is named team captain.

Jan 3th 2010: Cupcake Bowl VI - Hovan's Revenge

Cupcake Bowl VI was billed as Drew Brees's playoff return to The Snake Pit. Wearing a Hovantime! jersey, Brees propels Hovantime! to a 93-83 victory. Brees takes home MVP Honors as Hovan nation celebrates their first Cupcake Bowl victory.

Dec 23rd 2012: Cupcake Bowl VIII- deWheelchair's Vindication

After taking a ton of heat following the 2007 release of Drew Brees, Alexander deWheelchair coaches his team past the Brees-powered Hovantime! in Cupcake Bowl VIII. The 113 - 107 upset is JakeTheSnake16's 3rd Cupcake Bowl Victory in 5 appearances.
